Professional Summary

Hardworking, responsible and creative person. Since October 2018, I have been conducting my research within the **multidisciplinary** team of the Mediterranean Center for Sociology, Political Science and History. Drawing upon on the sociology of art and the dead, I examined the role of local administrations and states in the **requalification of complex objects** with **uncertain** legal and economic statuses. I have developed and applied an **analytical model** for the attribution of monumental value in **heteronomous** and **hierarchic** contexts, in dialogue with philosophy, history, anthropology, and law. My work highlights the deployment a **meritocratic** logic in the realm of funerary **historical monuments**, informing the sociology of valuation, of economy and of the state.
